FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE Vancouver Homebuilding Surpasses Last Year's

Vancouver, October 9, 2007 – Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation (CMHC) preliminary figures show that new home starts in the Vancouver Census Metropolitan Area (CMA) for the first nine months of 2007 have inched above last year's. Multiple family home starts to date were up 15 per cent, while single detached home starts lagged last year's by one third.

"Robust job growth has kept the resale home market very active in the Vancouver region and will keep demand for new homes solid into 2008. Strong increases in multiple family home construction in Burnaby, the Tri-Cities, Langley, West Vancouver and White Rock, have nudged home starts to date above last year's," said Robyn Adamache, Senior Market Analyst with CMHC."

Moving east, residential construction in the Fraser Valley remains high. Chilliwack registered a 46 per cent Home Starts Match Last Year's

home starts increase. Chilliwack has seen multiple family home starts more than double compared to the same period last year. Meanwhile, year-to-date, new home starts were down five per cent in the Abbotsford CMA. Growth in Abbotsford has been on the single detached home side.
