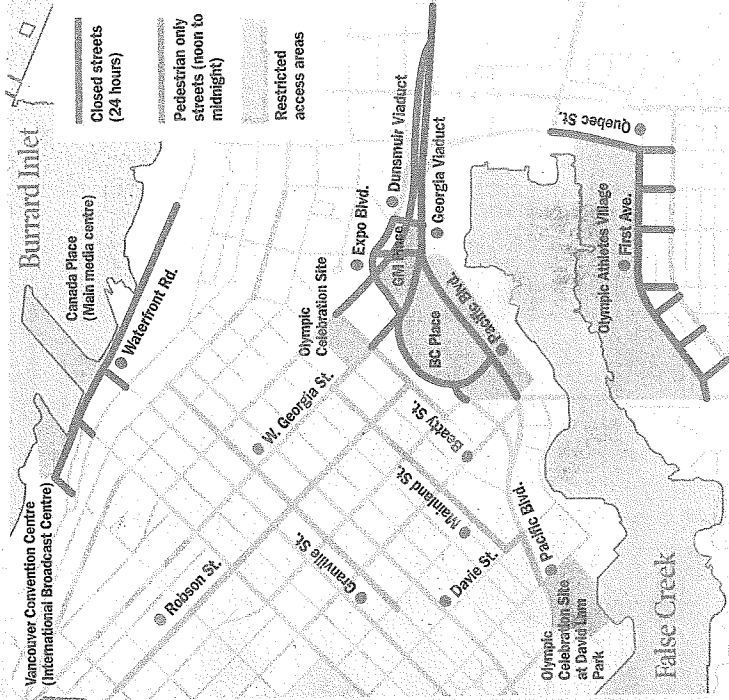

New 2010 look for the downtown

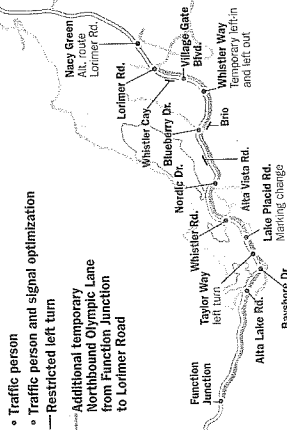
Vancouver will be transformed during the Games, with many roads closed to regular traffic and lots more transit.



- Closed streets (24 hours)
- Restricted access areas
- Pedestrian-only streets (noon to midnight)
- Streets with dedicated Olympic lane (24 hours)
- Parking restriction (24 hours)
- Parking restriction at intersections (24 hours)
- Parking for Olympic ticket holders taking shuttle buses to Whistler and Cypress
- Competition venues
- Training venues
- Entertainment sites
- Hotels for Olympic dignitaries, others

Whistler's plan of attack

With one main road, Whistler faces unique challenges. A checkpoint will discourage 'unnecessary trips' at peak periods.
